# IBGC Spring Spectacular Goat Sale

The inaugural IBGC Spring Spectacular Goat Sale was held on March 11, 2023 at the Daviess County Fairgrounds in Washington, Indiana. A full crowd of spectators was on hand with several more joining online via DVAuction in attempt to be the successful bidder on ninety lots from 31 consignors from Indiana, Illinois, and Kentucky. Consignors included 2M Boer Goats, 5BD Boer Goats, B.A.B. Boer Goats, Bateman Boer Goats, Be the Show Win the Show, Beavers Boer Goats, Box Alarm Farm, Bruno Livestock, Crown Ridge Showstock, Darr Farms, Dot Farm, Eschbacher Boer Goats, Fanning Farms, Fisher Boer Goats, Fuller Farm, Hefner Boer Goats, IN3B Boer Goats, Latham Livestock, Little Acres Farm, Madison Livestock, Mangold Show Goats, Morelock Showstock, MP Boer Goats, Nelson Show Stock, Newton Farms, Redden Brothers, Rollin R Farms, Stewart Farms Boer Goats, Stewart Show Stock, Wickard Livestock, and Workman Farms. Ike Redden was on hand to auctioneer and Makayla Richardson-Burns narrated the lots throughout the afternoon. The Washington County Kidding Around Goat Club served a delicious taco bar lunch. At the end of the afternoon, lots sold to 57 unique bidders hailing from Minnesota, Illinois, Missouri, Indiana, Ohio, Kentucky, New Hampshire, and Jamaica. The high selling market goat was consigned by B.A.B. Boer Goats of Terre Haute, Indiana. This heavy muscled, attractive profiled late December wether sold to Tanner Hollers of Indiana for \$2,000. The high selling breeding doe, RBMG O'Fallen was consigned by Redden Brothers of Norman, Indiana. This stylish, black headed junior percentage doe sold to the Stockberger Family of Indiana for \$4,500. Newton Farms consigned the high-selling buck, NF3 Newton Farms Rodeo Clown. Alfonso Miller was the bid winner at \$2,300, and will be exporting this heavy muscled, big footed February yearling buck to Jamaica. Two donation lots were auctioned off generating \$1,250 for the Indiana Boer Goat Classic to support our summer show series awards, scholarship, and workshop. The IBGC Executive Board and Youth Ambassadors are looking forward to hosting a sale in the Spring of 2024. We will also begin our 2023 Summer Show Series with both market and ABGA shows on April 15 with our first show in Rensselaer, Indiana. We encourage junior members in Indiana and surrounding states to join the IBGC and chase points in our series. High point exhibitors are awarded at our Fall Banquet, and we will also be awarding high point animals purchased from this sale and exhibited in our summer show series.
