



The IBGA Show Series is an opportunity for Youth Exhibitors to showcase their talents as Junior Showmen and exhibit their stock in a wholesome, family-oriented environment while earning points, prizes, and cash awards. The Show Series consists of a series of Youth Shows held each year in various locations throughout the State of Indiana.

During the IBGA Show Series, youth members of the Indiana Boer Goat Association compete for points in eleven categories: Market Showmanship, Breeding Showmanship, Market Goats, Dairy Wethers, Myotonic Wethers, Commercial Does, Commercial Bucks, ABGA Percentage Does, ABGA Percentage Bucks, ABGA Fullblood Does, and ABGA Fullblood Bucks' Points are awarded based on placings earned in these classes. Cash and/or merchandise prizes may also be awarded to youth members at shows for top placings in their classes.

The goal of the IBGA Show Series is to award outstanding youth exhibitors participating in the IBGA Show Series and encourage participation at all qualifying shows. By exhibiting at qualifying shows, every youth member has an opportunity to earn points based on guidelines below. Youth exhibitors must be IBGA junior members and may join at any show. Points accumulate from that show forward (no retroactive points are awarded).

Age Divisions

Junior age divisions are as of January 1 of the current year and are as follows:

Novice (4-7 years) Junior (8-12 years) Intermediate (13-16 years) Senior (17-21 years)

Showmanship

Top five (5) Showmanship exhibitors in each division (market and breeding) receive points at each show towards their total Showmanship Points. Exhibitors' four highest point events will be tallied towards High Point totals for the Series and the High Point Winner from each division receives awards. In the case of a tie for high point showmanship winner in each age division, a tie-breaker showdown will be held at the Fall Classic to determine the High Point Winner.

Market and Breeding Goats

Exhibitors receive points on their top three (3) placing animals per division, per show (outlined below). Exhibitors' four highest point events per division will be tallied towards High Point totals for the Series.

Points are awarded on a 10-point system for 1st through 10th place in classes with 6 or more entries. Points are awarded on a 5-point system for 1st through 5th place in classes with 5 or fewer entries. Any junior finishing lower than 10th place will receive 1 participation point. A disqualified animal will receive 0 points.

Youth Competition Points

Youth members will have the opportunity to compete in our youth competitions held at the IBGA Fall Classic. The competitions may be, but not limited to, a fitting contest, skill-a-thon, sales talk, and public speaking to occur at the IBGA Fall Classic. High Point winner(s) in their respective division will receive awards. Points from the competitions will not contribute to the overall points series.

Bonus Points

Four (4) IBGA shows count towards your year end points and bonus points will occur when exhibitors attend more than four (4) IBGA Show. Five (5) additional "bonus" points will be awarded to market goat and breeding goat exhibitors for each additional show after four (4) shows. For example, if you exhibit in 11 market goat shows throughout the season, you will automatically receive 35 additional points added to your market goat show total. If you exhibit in 9 breeding doe shows, you will receive 25 additional points added to your breeding doe show total. IBGA Show Series events include shows in the IBGA Shows and the Sanctioned Show Program. Bonus points are not awarded in the showmanship divisions.



Overall High Point Exhibitor

Exhibitors' four highest point events per category (Market Showmanship, Market Goat, Commercial Doe, Commercial Buck, Myotonic Wether, Dairy Wether, Breeding Showmanship, Percentage Doe, Percentage Buck, Fullblood Doe, and Fullblood Buck) at IBGA Shows and Sanctioned Shows will be tallied towards Overall High Point Exhibitor totals for the Series. Youth Competition Points are excluded, as are Bonus Points, for this calculation. Points shows are announced at the beginning of the year.

Year End Awards

Points from each show are tallied after the final IBGA Series Shows (only each exhibitor's four highest points are utilized) and Year End awards are given to the following:

- Top 5 Market Showmanship (by age: Novice, Junior, Intermediate, Senior)
- Top 5 Breeding Showmanship (by age: Novice, Junior, Intermediate, Senior)
- Top 5 Market Goat Exhibitors
- Top 5 Commercial Doe Exhibitors
- Top 5 Commercial Buck Exhibitors
- Top 5 Myotonic Wether Exhibitors
- Top 5 Dairy Wether Exhibitors
- Top 5 Percentage Doe Exhibitors
- Top 5 Percentage Buck Exhibitors
- Top 5 Fullblood Doe Exhibitors
- Top 5 Fullblood Buck Exhibitors
- Top 2 Youth Competition Exhibitors (by age: Novice, Junior, Intermediate, Senior)
- Top 10 Overall Exhibitors
- High Point and Reserve High Point Animals in each division*
- High Point and Reserve High Point Sale Animals; the animal must be purchased and exhibited by the junior exhibitor who purchased the animal at the IBGA Spring Spectacular Sale. *
- Bred and Owned High Point and Reserve High Point Animals in each division. Animals must be bred and owned by the exhibitor, as determined by registration paperwork, or by declaring at the initial time an animal is shown in the series (via permanent ID, market). *
